## 2004 Christmas Handicap Tournament

**Tuesday 28 December**

The format will be the same as last year with all matches played on handicap within a small group. Each group will play all its matches in a three-hour period and within these three hours you should be on court for about two hours overall, playing two sets of singles and two sets of doubles. Group winners will go through to the finals on the Tuesday evening. The commitment is to be available for one (but the more you sign up for the better) of the four three-hour sessions and for the final on Tuesday evening which starts at six o'clock. This is a social event as well as a competitive tournament. Competitors will be playing members that they may not usually play.

The cost of the tournament will be £15 (debited to your account) (or £5 if you are an Annual Season Ticket holder) to include the marking on the final evening, the court time, and the food & drink (one glass of wine or beer — any more to be paid additionally) during the tournament.

Entrants must have entered the results of at least six matches (against at least four different opponents) from the 1 October 2004 and not have volatile handicap status to be eligible.

Entries may be restricted and you should indicate for which of the periods you are free. If the number of entries exceeds the limit, then entry to the tournament will be decided on the number and time of sessions for which you are available (to make the organizer's job easier) as well as on who has written their name down first. Priority will be given to availability.

Please write your name and the sessions for which you are available on the sheet below. The times shown indicate the start of the three hour session. I have also included a column entitled "Beer"; I am thinking of having a barrel of Adnam's available and I needed to judge the consumption; please enter, in this column, the anticipated amount of beer that you may drink.

Entries close on Saturday 18 December and you will be notified shortly after that date of when you will be required to play.
