## **Cambridge University Real Tennis Club: Safety Policy**

Cambridge University Real Tennis Club (CURTC) is strongly committed to encouraging our members to take part in the game whilst seeking to ensure that their and others' safety is managed effectively.

To support the above Safety policy statement CURTC is committed to the following duties:

- Ensure CURTC professionals are first aid trained.
- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessments of the club premises including fire alarms and electrical installations and of all activities undertaken by the Club.
- Carry out an annual condition survey of all Club equipment.
- Create a safe environment by putting safety measures in place as identified by risk assessments.
- Use best efforts to ensure members are aware of the Club's Safety Policy.
- Ensure Club's first aid boxes contain basic first aid kit and are visible and close to where accidents are most likely to occur e.g. by the courts.
- Ensure that any injuries or accidents sustained during any Club activity or whilst on the Club premises are reported, and recorded in the accident book by the Club professionals.
- Appoint a competent Club member to oversee the Club's safety responsibilities.
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

## Expectations of Club members:

- Take reasonable care of their own safety as well as the safety of others.
- Co-operate with the Club on safety issues, both inside the club premises and outside in the Club's parking space.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the Club.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for members' health, safety or welfare.
